 - A = Author. Put your name on the paper.
 - D = Date. Put the date on the paper.
- 3. Label bodies of water and peninsulas (see list below) in ALL CAPS. Water is shaded gray so it is easier to see.
- 4. Draw in mountain ranges and label them using regular case.
- 5. Label rivers using regular case.
- 6. Label deserts using regular case and shade with a light color.
