Directions

- 1. Do all work neatly. This cannot be stressed enough. It will be difficult to read your map if it is messy, thereby rendering it useless for studying.
- 2. TOAD the map.
 - T = Title. Does it have a title? If not, add one.
 - O = Orientation. Does it have a compass rose? If not, add one in an inconspicuous spot.
 - A = Author. Put your name on the paper.
 - D = Date. Put the date on the paper.
- 3. Label bodies of water and peninsulas (see list below) in ALL CAPS. Water is shaded gray so it is easier to see.
- 4. Draw in mountain ranges and label them using regular case.
- 5. Label rivers using regular case.
- 6. Label deserts using regular case and shade with a light color.
- 7. Find the Nile River delta and highlight it. Knowledge probe time: What is a delta? Write a definition here:
- 8. The Aral Sea is shown on your map, but you may have trouble finding it on a current map of the region. Knowledge probe time: What happened to the Aral Sea and what caused it? Write the answer here:
